Load film roll on to the main roll spidle. *Ensure the air channel is facing inwards.

Feed the film through the guide spindles. See below for correct path.


Holding film firmly. Press the "forward' button to guide film to the end of the rollers. Release button when film reaches the end.



* There may be resistance due to air channel passing through cutter, this is normal.



Secure the roll with the end boss and stop firmly.

Attach film to the air nozzle and feed through to the first roller.



*Use your thumb and finger to open the air channel.



Important: Film should be flat and parrallel to rollers. Use the 'Forward' & 'Reverse' buttons to ensure correct film alignment.

Adjusting Speed and Air Pressure



Refer to film guide which contains your optimum air pressure and speed settings.



Turn 'Speed Dial' until required speed setting is indicated on 'Speed Indicator'..





Pull 'Pressure setting' knob upwards to release the lock. Whilst looking at Pressure Display, turn the knob clockwise/anti-clockwise to set correct air pressure.



Push 'Pressure Setting' knob down to lock the setting.





Inflation



Once roll is correctly loaded and Speed/Air Pressure is set to film guide specifications. Press the 'Start/Stop' button to start inflation.

Once 'Start/Stop' button has been pressed, minor adjustments in air pressure may be required. Use 'Pressure Setting' knob to adjust the air pressure whilst machine is in operation.



To stop inflation simply press 'Start/Stop' button.
